## News Conference: Commissioners to unveil new Oakland County Fair Housing Initiative to prevent source of income housing discrimination

- WHAT:** The Oakland County Board of Commissioners (BOC) and local fair housing leaders will unveil the proposed new Oakland County Fair Housing Initiative to prevent source of income housing discrimination and eliminate other barriers to fair housing. Source of income discrimination prevents residents who participate in the federally funded housing choice voucher program, or other forms of rental assistance, from accessing housing. The housing choice voucher program is the federal government's program for assisting low-income families, the elderly, and the disabled afford suitable housing in the private market. When those who participate in the program are discriminated against, their access to adequate housing is unfairly limited.
- To address this issue, commissioners will be unveiling a legislative package slated for introduction.
